L.O.I.D. Terms of Use and Operating Instructions

Fire hydrant meters are approved for use on L.O.I.D. hydrants only. Using a L.O.I.D. fire hydrant meter outside of L.O.I.D.'s service area is considered theft and may be prosecuted by the affected water purveyor. Dual charges may also apply.

Permit fee and meter deposit must be paid and any vehicles connecting to hydrant must be inspected and approved for backflow prevention before the permit will be issued.

Application for temporary water service will not be approved if, in the opinion of L.O.I.D., the purpose of the application can be accomplished through a permanent connection to the water system.

L.O.I.D. must be notified prior to relocating the meter. A \$50 relocation fee will be applied to the account. If the meter is moved without proper authority, the developer will be charged an illegal use fee of \$100.00 in addition to any additional charges for damages and/or repairs to the meter.

The amount of the deposit will be refunded only after the meter and materials have been returned to L.O.I.D. in good condition, and the account has been paid in full. If the meter is damaged, only a partial refund may be possible.

Operation Instructions

Fire hydrant must be opened and closed slowly. Failure to do so could result in a water main break.

When the hydrant is in use, it must be in the fully open position.

A valve on the meter must be used to control the flow volume of water. The valve should be in the closed position before opening the fire hydrant.

Only fire hydrant wrenches may be used to operate the fire hydrant.

When not in use, the fire hydrant must be left in the closed position with all nozzle caps in place. Hoses and any other apparatus must never be left on the fire hydrant when not in use.

Any apparent damage or malfunction of a fire hydrant must be reported immediately to L.O.I.D. at (208) 746-8235 or the L.O.I.D. Foreman at (208) 790-2287. Repairs to a fire hydrant will be performed by L.O.I.D. personnel only.

In freezing weather, the fire hydrant, meter, and all issued materials must be protected from freezing.

L.O.I.D., police, and the fire department reserve the right to interrupt the use of a fire hydrant at any time.
